**SCHEDULE L
OUTDOOR LIGHT RATE**

AVAILABILITY

Available to the individual customer for lighting of private and public outdoor areas at locations on the CPW's distribution system. This Schedule is intended for all standard, non-decorative lighting. Service under this Schedule may be withheld or discontinued at the option of the CPW.

Owner of property must sign rental light agreement for 5-year period.

- (1) Non-LED lighting includes any other luminaire that is not a Light Emitting Diode (LED). This includes, but not limited to, high pressure sodium vapor (HPS), metal halide, and mercury vapor luminaires.
- (2) Non-LED lightning installations are closed to new installs effective 10/31/2016.
- (3) Light Emitting Diode (LED) lights are available for new installations after 11/01/2016, and as replacements for non-LED lights as the non-LED lighting fixtures become non-operational and as resources and supplies are available. Replacement of operational lighting is subject to the Transition Fee listed below.
- (4) Consumption Only - Available for all night outdoor lighting service to any customer that pre-pays for the entire costs of the lighting facilities, or any customer that enters into a financing agreement, with CPW, to re-pay the entire costs of the lighting facilities necessary for service under this schedule. Financing agreements are only applicable to Government entities and subdivision developers.

LIMITATIONS AND ADDITIONAL FEES

Standard, non-decorative LED luminaires available for new installations include the installation of one (1) lighting fixture, installed on one (1) standard pole (length determined by CPW engineers), and includes underground or overhead service up to 150 feet.

Additional Fees

Additional luminaires can be installed and include the following additional rates:

Additional pole(s) - \$65 each pole
 Additional overhead service (ft) - \$1.75 per linear foot
 Additional underground service (ft) - \$2.57 per linear foot

Transition Fees

CPW will replace operational non-LED lighting with an LED light fixture upon payment of a transition fee in the amount of \$50.00, in advance to CPW, per lighting fixture.

OTHER LIGHTING FIXTURES

Decorative and non-standard lighting can be installed on request, at CPW's option, at the monthly charges listed above plus an amount to fully recover the costs associated with the decorative and non-standard lighting equipment necessary, including costs for fixtures, poles and associated labor. These costs will be determined by CPW and paid in advance to CPW prior to installation. Financing of the costs are at the discretion of CPW through a financing agreement.

SALES TAX

Any applicable sales tax will be added to the monthly bill as determined above.

INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE

The CPW will make reasonable provisions to ensure satisfactory and continuous service, but does not guarantee a continuous supply of electrical power and energy and shall not be liable for damage occasioned by interruptions of service or failure to commence delivery caused by acts of God, or the public enemy, or for any cause reasonably beyond its control, including, but not limited to the failure or breakdown of facilities, floods, fire, strikes, or action or orders of any agency having jurisdiction in the premises, or for interruptions which are necessary for inspection, repair, or changes in equipment or facilities of the CPW or its bulk power suppliers. The customer shall notify the CPW immediately of any defects, trouble or accident that may in any way affect the delivery of electric service by the CPW.

PAYMENT

Bills are due and payable on the date of the bill at the offices of the Greer Commission of Public Works. Bills are past due and delinquent on the nineteenth (19th) day after the date of the bill, at which time customer will be assessed a late charge equal to five percent (5%) of the unpaid past due amount. Disconnection may occur on the 29th day after the date of bill or thereafter, unless prior arrangements have been made with the CPW. Any customer who has his or her services terminated for non-payment shall also be subject to a \$50.00 reconnect fee for services to be restored during normal business hours or a \$75.00 reconnect fee if services are restored after normal business hours.
