AVAILABILITY

This rate schedule is available to residential and small commercial sewer customers within the territory served by the CPW and inside the corporate limits of the Taylors Fire and Sewer District, and Renewable Water Resources (ReWa) treats sewer collected.

BASE CHARGES

Facilities Charge: \$ 14.12 per month

Volume Charges: All gallons \$ 0.04607 per 10 gallons

Plus a treatment fee from ReWa, see Rate Schedules S700 and S800

The ReWa rates are subject to change at any time. CPW will adjust its billings to reflect ReWa's rate changes as they occur.

SEWER CAP

A residential customer will not be billed for monthly sewer flows more than the following:

MINIMUM MONTHLY BILL

The minimum monthly charge shall be the "Facilities Charge".

SALES TAX AND MUNICIPAL FEES

Any applicable sales tax or other fee assessed by or remitted to a state or local government authority will be added to the charges determined above.

INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE

The CPW will make reasonable provisions to ensure satisfactory and continuous service, but does not guarantee a continuous collection of sewer and shall not be liable for damage occasioned by interruptions of service or failure to commence delivery caused by acts of God, or the public enemy, or for any cause reasonably beyond its control, including, but not limited to the failure or breakdown of facilities, floods, fire, strikes, or action or orders of any agency having jurisdiction in the premises, or for interruptions which are necessary for inspection, repair, or changes in equipment or facilities of the CPW. The customer shall notify the CPW immediately of any defects, trouble or accident that may in any way affect the collection of sewer service by the CPW.

SINGLE POINT COLLECTION

The above rates are based upon the collection of service to the customer's premises through a single collection point. Separate collection for the same customer at other points of collection shall be separately billed.

PAYMENT

Bills are due and payable on the due date of the bill at the offices of the Greer Commission of Public Works. Bills are past due and delinquent on the first business day after the due date shown on bill, at which time customer will be assessed a late charge equal to five percent (5%) of the most current unpaid past due amount. Disconnection may occur on the 11th day following the due date of bill or thereafter, unless prior arrangements have been made with the CPW. Any customer who has their services terminated for non-payment shall also be subject to a \$50.00 reconnect fee for services to be restored during normal business hours.

OBLIGATIONS

The obligations of the CPW regarding supplying sewer collection service are dependent upon its securing and retaining all necessary rights-of-way, privileges and permits for the delivery of such service. The CPW shall not be liable to any customer or applicant for sewer collection service in the event it is delayed in, or is prevented from, furnishing the sewer collection service by its failure to secure and retain such rights-of-way, privileges and permits.
